Establishments that primarily perform these activities independent of the agriculture or forestry producing establishment are in this subsector. \*NAICS 1151 (Support Activities for Crop Production) 1152 (Support Activities for Animal Production) 1153 (Support Activities for Forestry).

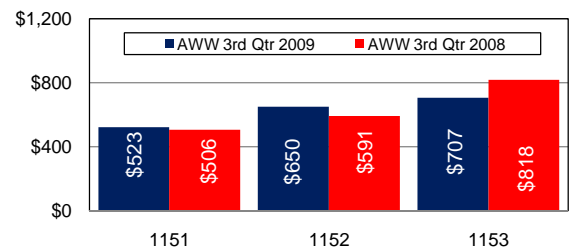

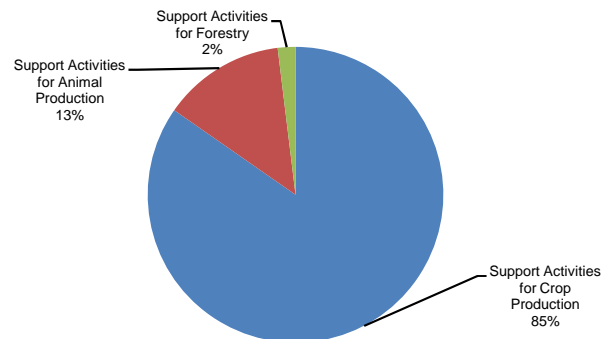
## Average Weekly Wage
