## Industry Description

Industries in the Utilities subsector provide electric power, natural gas, steam supply, water supply, and sewage removal through a permanent infrastructure of lines, mains, and pipes. Establishments are grouped together based on the utility service provided and the particular system or facilities required to perform the service. This industry includes establishments primarily engaged in generating, transmitting, and/or distributing electric power. Also included are: establishments primarily engaged in operating gas distribution systems, gas marketers that buy gas from the well and sell it to a distribution system, gas brokers or agents that arrange the sale of gas over gas distribution systems operated by others, and establishments primarily engaged in transmitting and distributing gas to final consumers. Utilities also includes establishments primarily engaged in operating water treatment plants and/or operating water supply systems. \*NAICS 2211 (Electric Power Generation, Transmission and Distribution) 2212 (Natural Gas Distribution) 2213 (Water, Sewage and Other Systems).

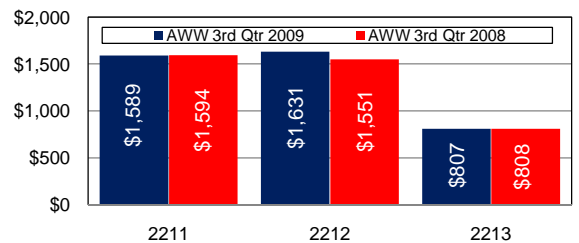
## Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 1999-2009

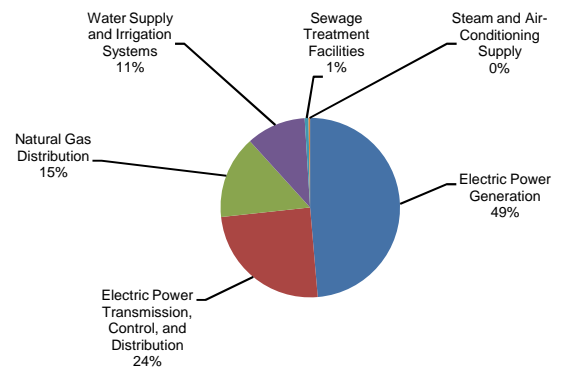
## Average Weekly Wage
