

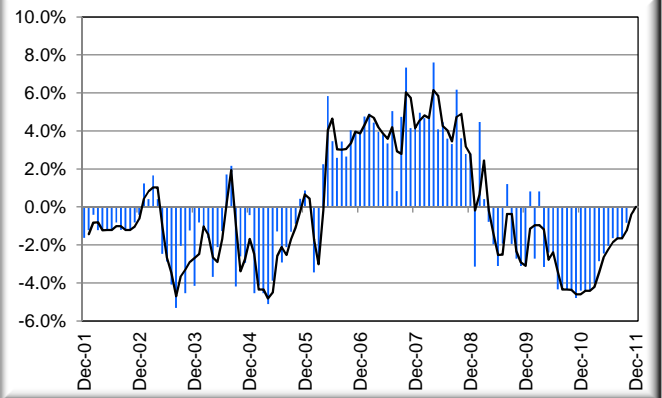

Petroleum and Coal Products Manufacturing NAICS 324 (Private Industry Only)

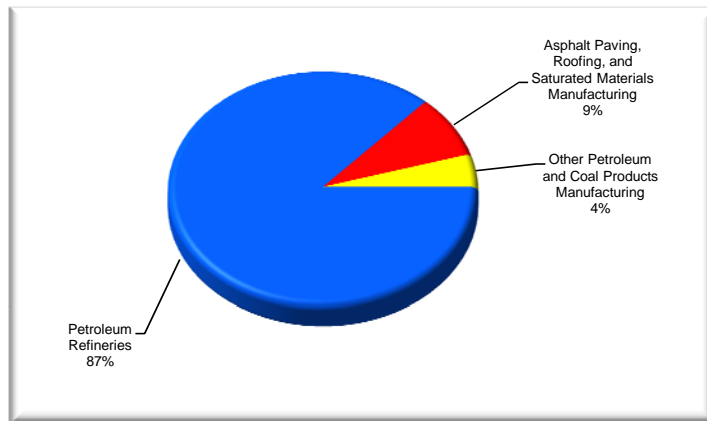
Industry Description

The Petroleum and Coal Products Manufacturing subsector is based on the transformation of crude petroleum and coal into usable products. The dominant process is petroleum refining that involves the separation of crude petroleum into component products through such techniques as cracking and distillation. In addition, this subsector includes establishments that primarily further process refined petroleum and coal products and produce products, such as asphalt coatings and petroleum lubricating oils. *NAICS 3241 (Petroleum & Coal Products Manufacturing).

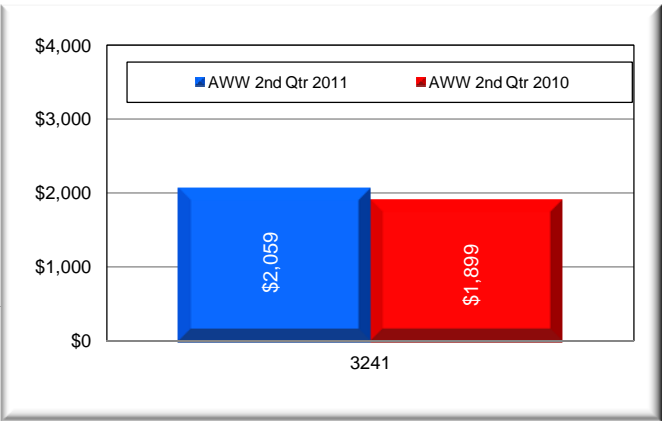
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 2001-2011

Average Weekly Wage



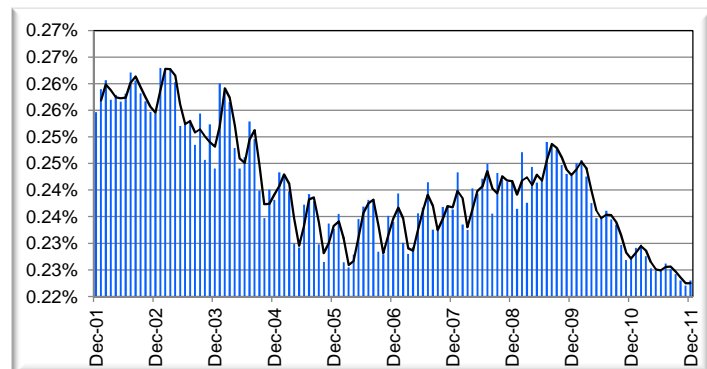
