

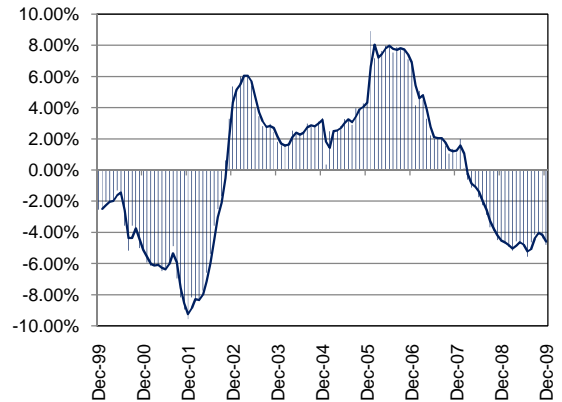

NAICS 336 (Private Industry Only)

Industry Description

Industries in the Transportation Equipment Manufacturing subsector produce equipment for transporting people and goods. Establishments in this subsector utilize production processes similar to those of other machinery manufacturing establishments - bending, forming, welding, machining, and assembling metal or plastic parts into components and finished products. However, the assembly of components and subassemblies and their further assembly into finished vehicles tends to be a more common production process in this subsector than in the Machinery Manufacturing subsector. *NAICS 3361 (Motor Vehicle Mfg) 3362 (Motor Vehicle Body and Trailer Mfg) 3363 (Motor Vehicle Mfg) 3364 (Aerospace Product and Parts Mfg) 3365 (Railroad Rolling Stock Mfg) 3366 (Ship and Boat Building) 3369 (Other Transportation Equipment Mfg).

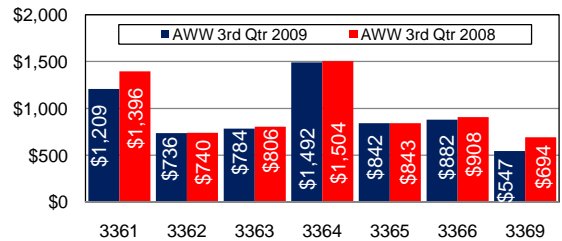
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 1999-2009



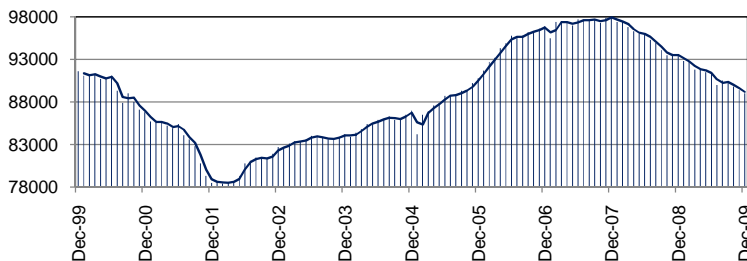

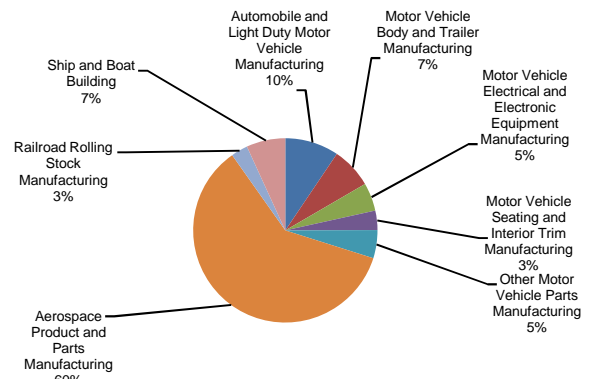
Average Weekly Wage



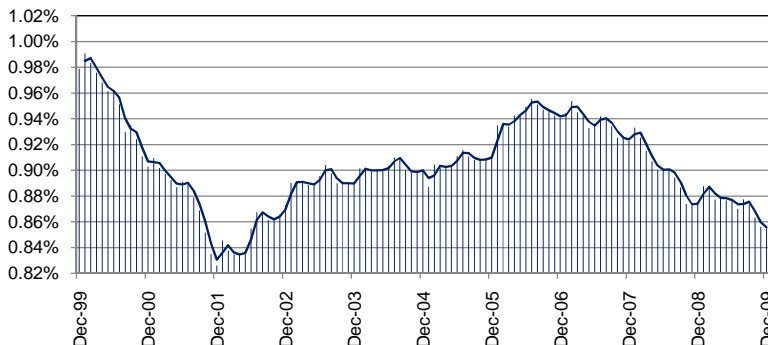
Total Nonagricultural Employment Levels for Transportation Equipment Manufacturing
