

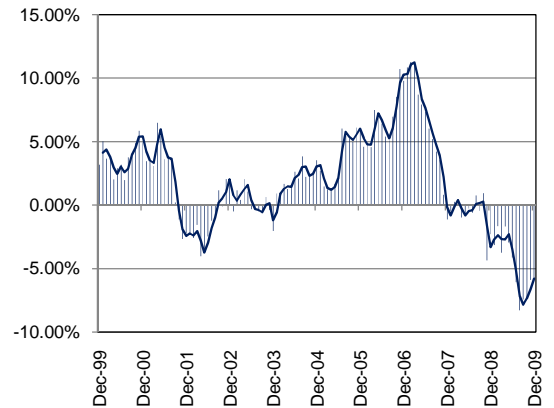

Industry Description

Industries in the Rail Transportation subsector provide rail transportation of passengers and/or cargo using railroad rolling stock. The railroads in this subsector primarily either operate on networks, with physical facilities, labor force, and equipment spread over an extensive geographic area, or operate over a short distance on a local rail line. *NAICS 4821 (Rail Transportation).

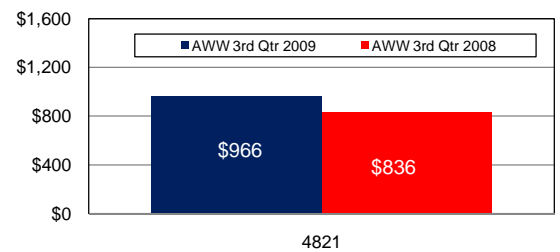
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 1999-2009



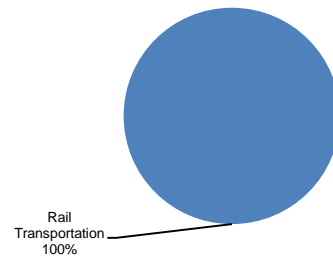

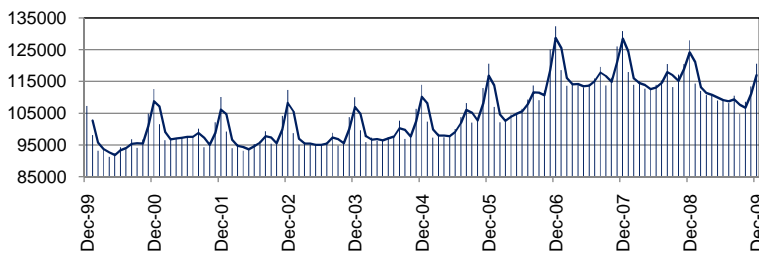
Average Weekly Wage



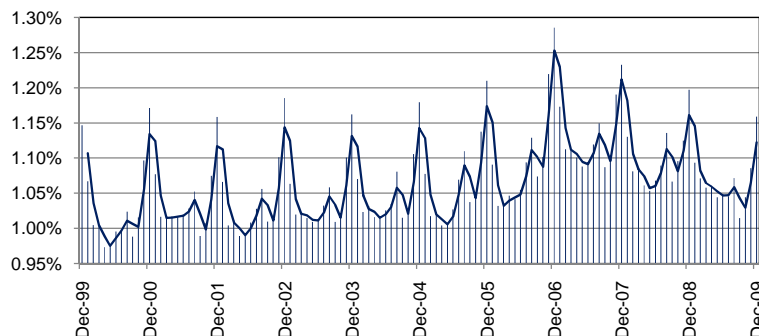
Component Breakout 3rd Quarter 2009
