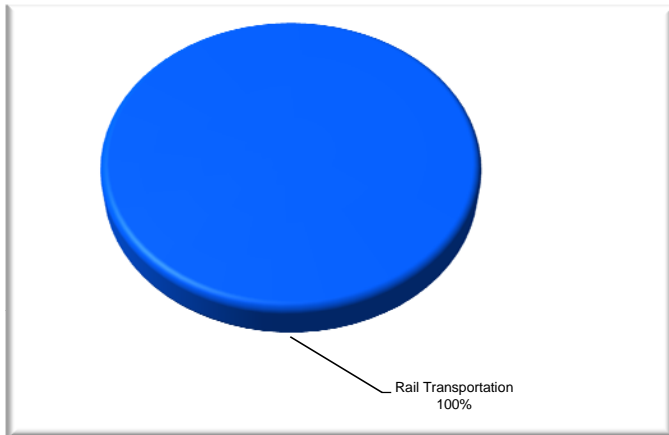
Industry Description

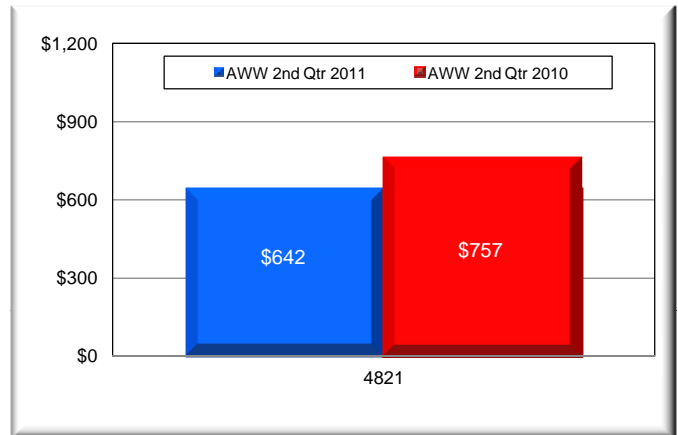
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 2001-2011
