

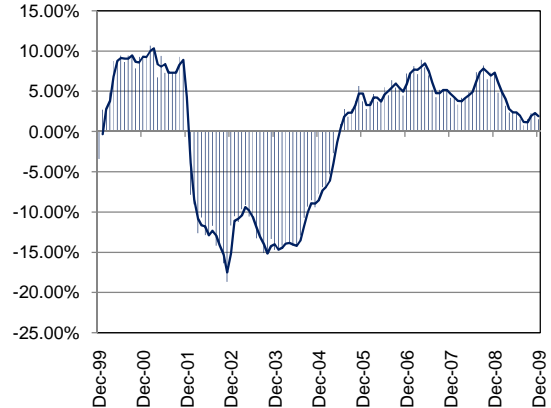

Pipeline Transportation
NAICS 486 (Private Industry Only)

Industry Description

Industries in the Pipeline Transportation subsector use transmission pipelines to transport products, such as crude oil, natural gas, refined petroleum products, and slurry. Industries are identified based on the products transported (i.e., pipeline transportation of crude oil, natural gas, refined petroleum products, and other products). The Pipeline Transportation of Natural Gas industry includes the storage of natural gas because the storage is usually done by the pipeline establishment and because a pipeline is inherently a network in which all the nodes are interdependent. *NAICS 4861 (Pipeline Transportation of Crude Oil) 4862 (Pipeline Transportation of Natural Gas) 4869 (Other Pipeline Transportation).

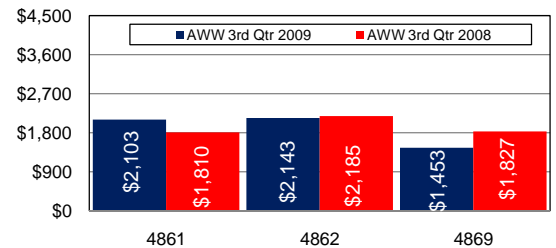
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 1999-2009



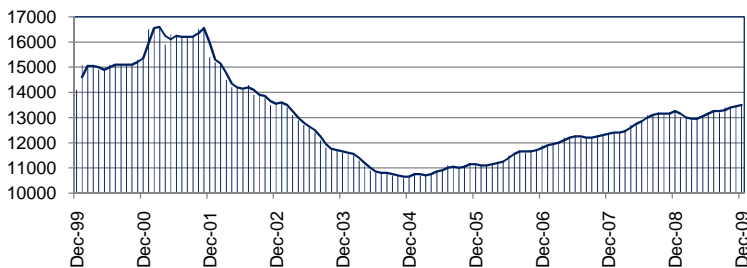

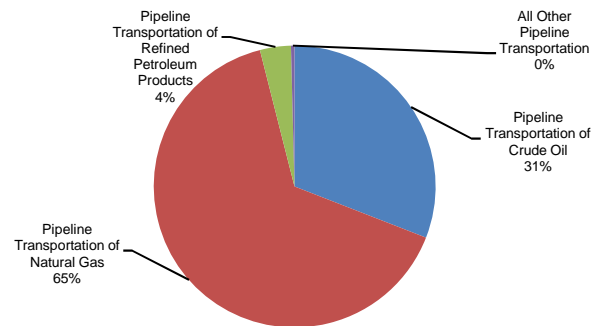
Average Weekly Wage



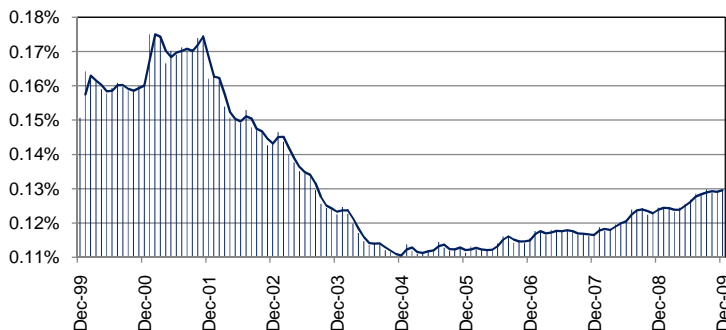
Total Nonagricultural Employment Levels for Pipeline Transportation
