

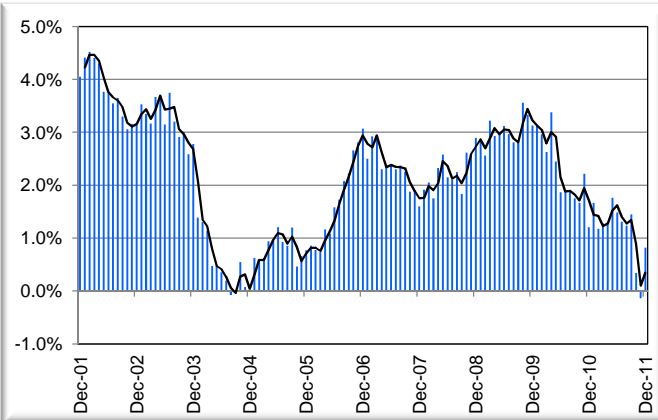

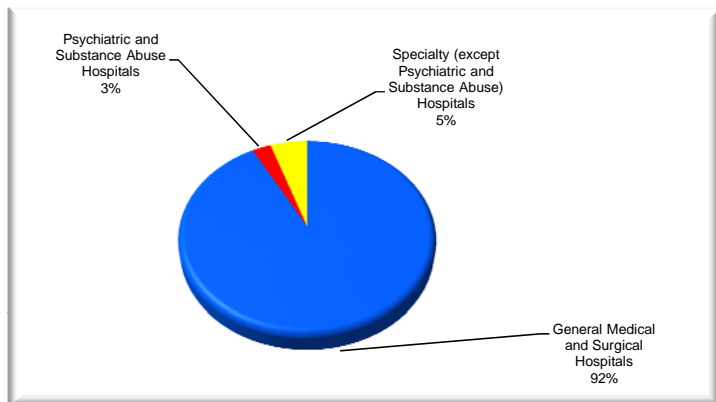
Industry Description

Industries in the Hospitals subsector provide medical, diagnostic, and treatment services that include physician, physician assistant, nursing, and other health services to inpatients and the specialized accommodation services required by inpatients. Hospitals may also provide outpatient services as a secondary activity. Establishments in the Hospitals subsector provide inpatient health services, many of which can only be provided using the specialized facilities and equipment that form a significant and integral part of the production process. *NAICS 6221 (General Medical and Surgical Hospitals) 6222 (Psychiatric and Substance Abuse Hospitals) 6223 (Specialty (except Psychiatric and Substance Abuse) Hospitals).

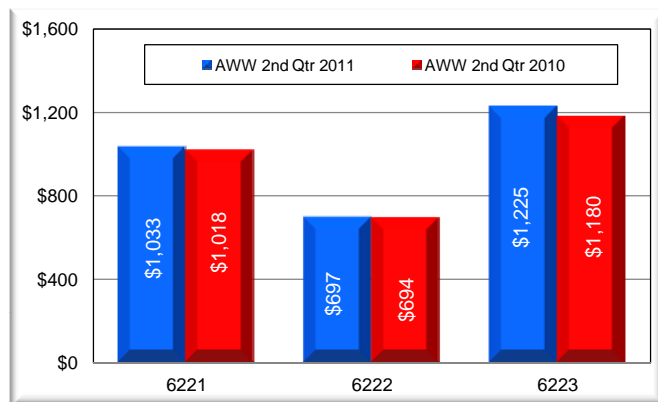
Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 2001-2011

Average Weekly Wage



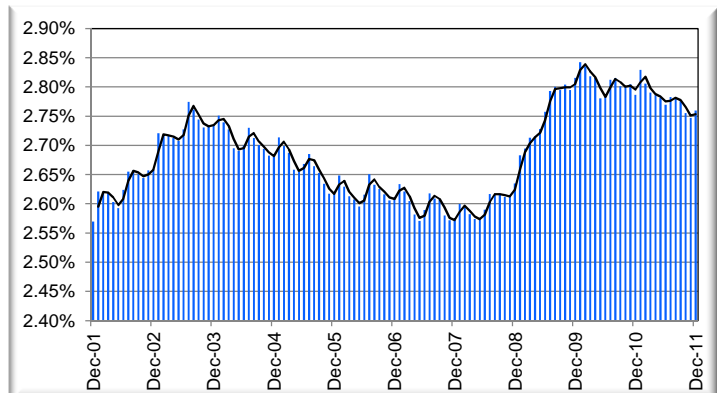
