

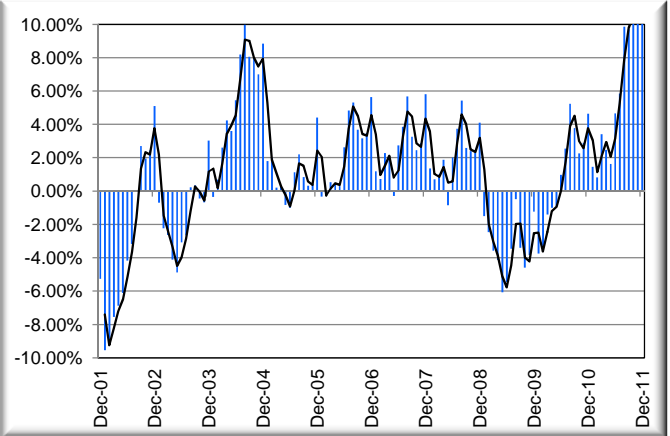

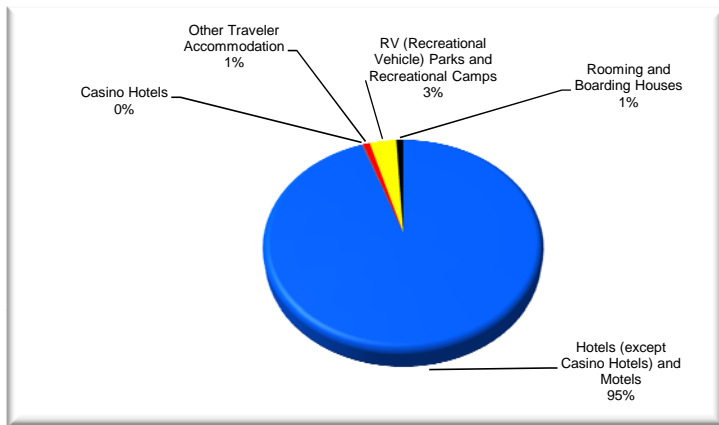
## Industry Description

Industries in the Accommodation subsector provide lodging or short-term accommodations for travelers, vacationers, and others. There is a wide range of establishments in these industries. Some provide lodging only; while others provide meals, laundry, and recreational facilities, as well as lodging. Lodging establishments are classified in this subsector even if the provision of complementary services generates more revenue. The type of complementary services provided vary from establishment to establishment. \*NAICS 7211 (Traveler Accommodation) 7212 (RV Parks and Recreational Camps) 7213 (Rooming and Boarding Homes).

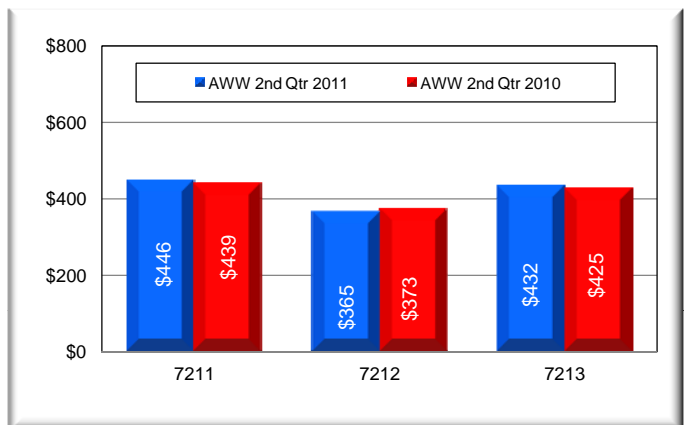
## Total Nonagricultural Annual Employment Growth Rate 2001-2011

## Average Weekly Wage



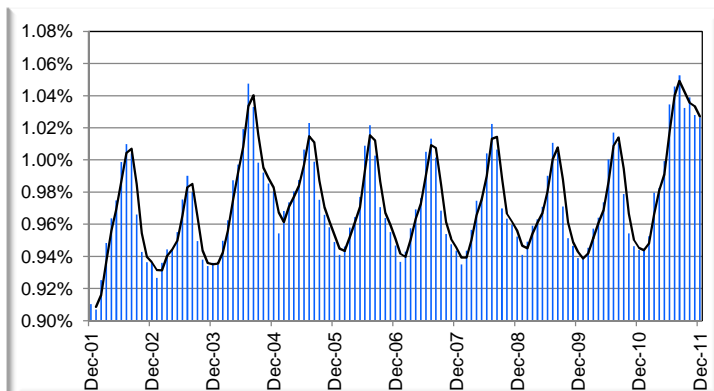
